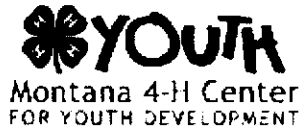


Minutes

Skill-a-Thon – don't have to be entered in the projects to enter


